Hardware Requirements

- PC (Pentium or better) or Macintosh (PowerPC or better) computer
- High speed Internet connection
 - T1 or better
 - Cable
 - Connection by dial-up modem (AOL, etc.) is not supported
- Sound card and speakers
- Monitor set to:
 - 800 x 600 resolution or higher
 - 16 bit color (Thousands of colors) or higher

Software Requirements

- Netscape Navigator 3.0+ or
- Microsoft Internet Explorer 3.0+
- Java and Javascript enabled
- RealPlayer G2 or 5.0 plug-in
The RealPlayer G2 or 5.0 plugins may be downloaded for free from <http://www.real.com> and must be installed prior to viewing the presentation
