- ✦ **The goal of the committee is to create an ideal that campuses could work toward using, but would not be mandated.**

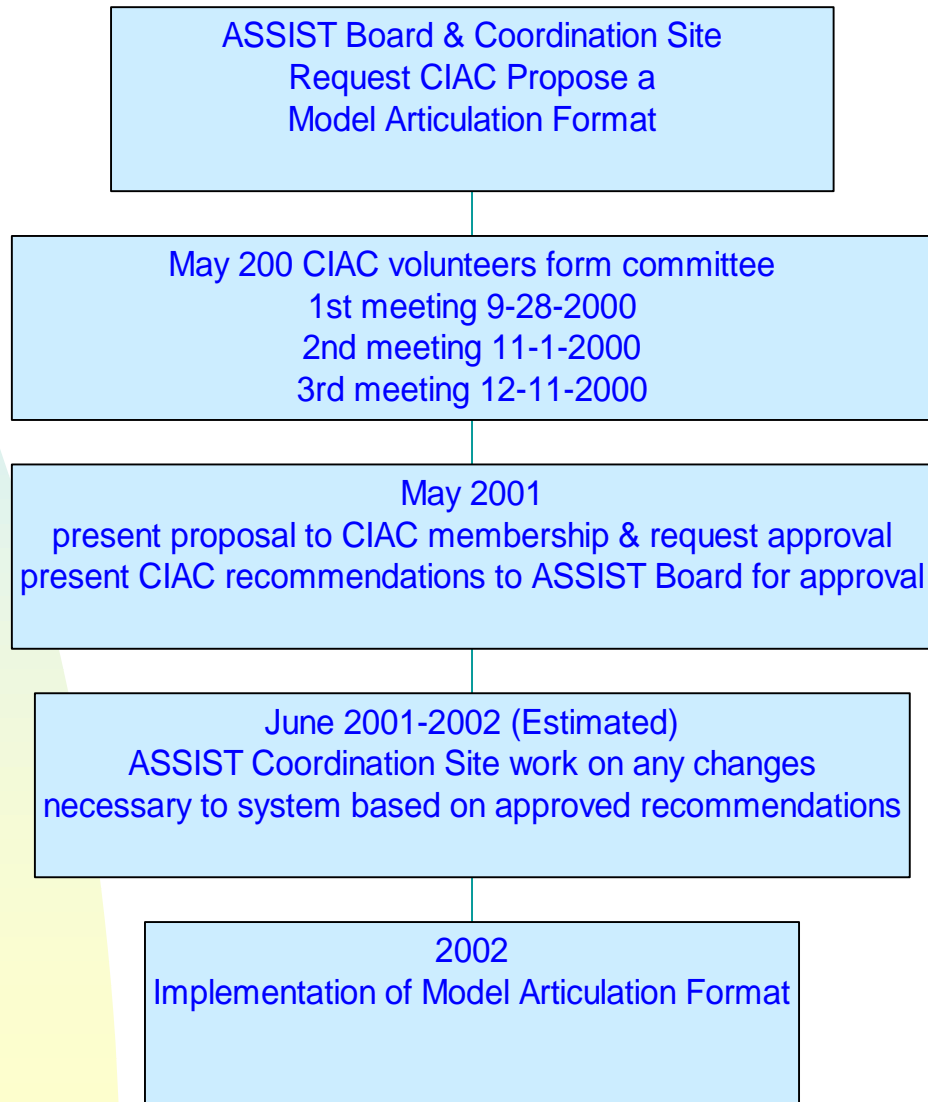
Purpose
