Keeping it Current

There's a lot of valuable information on the ASSIST Web pages, but there may be some things you are not aware of in ASSIST. Besides the new articulation agreements that are published every day in ASSIST, there are new majors as well as changes and additions to transferable courses entered regularly. Since this information is literally at your fingertips in ASSIST, we want to make sure you know about it so you can use it. The fact is that there is always something new in ASSIST.

Explore Majors

You find articulation information in ASSIST by following the path through Exploring Transfer Information or Exploring Majors. The Exploring Majors path offers students a chance to search through majors at all UC and CSU campuses, compare emphases and requirements, and see how their community college courses meet the university major requirements.

ASSIST Articulation

In addition to articulation agreements between institutions, ASSIST offers information about courses that are transferable to UC and CSU for credit, that meet GE certification patterns (IGETC and CSU GE/Breadth), and that fulfill the CSU American Ideals requirement. To give you an idea of just how much this information changes and why it's important to check ASSIST for the latest information, we've put together a list showing the number of changes to transferable courses that have been entered for the current year.
