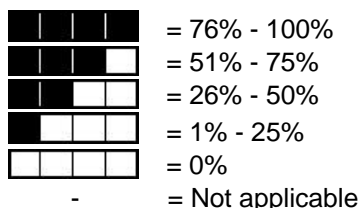

Notes: a. While this report only includes information on 99-00 articulation agreements, most universities have extensive articulation available through ASSIST in prior years that remains important for transfer planning

b. While UC Santa Cruz does not have any 99-00 articulation agreements in ASSIST due to local issues, they have extensive articulation in ASSIST for prior years

- Columns:
1. Quantity of Current 99-00 Agreements: Presents the proportion of articulation agreements that each university has with all (107) California Community Colleges in ASSIST covering 99-00
  2. Service Area Coverage: Presents the proportion of articulation agreements that each university has with California Community Colleges in its local service area in ASSIST covering 99-00
  3. Major Preparation Agreements: Presents the median number of distinct majors within each articulation agreement for 99-00 combined with the number of colleges covered
  4. Discipline Based Agreements: Presents the median number of distinct disciplines within each articulation agreement for 99-00 combined with the number of colleges covered
  5. Subjective Quality of Agreements: 4 point scale representing a subjective evaluation of the overall quality of a typical agreement for each university—based on criteria such as general readability, inclusion of course titles/units, additional clarifying/descriptive information, inclusion of common requirements not articulated with the individual college
