

Each Fall the ASSIST Coordination Site asks all California Community Colleges to provide copies of any current and official articulation with CSU or UC campuses that they have received electronically or on paper that is not available in ASSIST. The Coordination Site then confirms whether or not the information is in ASSIST and then follows up with individual CSU and UC campuses to let them know of any problems.

The following is a summary of all reports submitted by CCC articulation officers:

## **UC Campuses**

### **UCLA**

De Anza College 99-00 GE Agreement

Comment: CCs were asked to provide current articulation not in ASSIST. UCLA no longer articulates GE agreements.

## **CSU Campuses**

### **Cal Poly Pomona**

De Anza College Journalism Courses

Comment: CCs were asked to provide current articulation not in ASSIST. These courses were articulated in 98-99.

### **CSU Chico**

De Anza College courses to fulfill Ethnic and Non-Western Studies GE requirement

Comment: CCs were asked to provide current articulation not in ASSIST. This agreement is from 2001. CSUC does not officially articulate GE with community colleges.

### **CSU Monterey Bay**

Southwestern College Course-to Course and Majors articulation

Comment: Articulation is in ASSIST as of 2/04

**CSU San Bernardino**

Southwestern College Course-to-Course articulation

Comment: 2002-03 articulation is in ASSIST.

**San Diego State University**

Southwestern College Course-to-Course Articulation and San Diego Regional Grid

Comment: Course to Course articulation is in ASSIST as of 2/04. There is no facility in ASSIST to enter regional grids.
