

**CCC/CSU/UC**  
**Joint Resolution Endorsing ASSIST**  
**as California's Official Repository**  
**for Articulation and Transfer Information**

Draft - October 13, 1998

**Whereas** the State of California has demonstrated a long term commitment to student transfer through the Master Plan and numerous projects and activities, and;

**Whereas** California's public post-secondary systems have collaborated in developing ASSIST (Articulation System Stimulating Inter-institutional Student Transfer) to automate course articulation information for use by students, faculty, advisors and other staff, and;

**Whereas** all of the most current, official articulation that has been established among California public Community Colleges and universities is now in ASSIST and being maintained and updated actively by those institutions, and;

**Whereas** the ASSIST Board of Directors is currently working with the AICCU to develop policies and practices to expand ASSIST to include articulation with independent California colleges and universities, and;

**Whereas** ASSIST is now universally available to all California students, faculty, advisors and staff via the World Wide Web;

**Be it resolved** that the leaders of the California Community College, California State University, and University of California systems along with the California Postsecondary Education Commission endorse ASSIST as California's official, statewide repository of articulation and transfer information.
