

**An Investigative Report and Evaluation of Articulation Not in Assist
as of September 2001**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Supplemental Language Report (SLR) for the University of California in the 2001-2002 Budget Act requests “the proportion of all existing articulation agreements that are included on the ASSIST Web site.” The request raises once again the issue of monitoring compliance with ASSIST complete data policies which require that official articulation be entered into ASSIST within one month of approval by the receiving institution’s articulation officer. Since non-compliance can be gauged by the Coordination Site only to the extent that campuses report it, the accounting of the problem until now has been anecdotal. The ASSIST Board of Directors responded preliminarily in the November 2001 Report to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee that of the more than 3,100 current articulation agreements in ASSIST, the ASSIST Board had received reports of only 2 incomplete agreements. This supplementary investigation intends to more thoroughly respond to the Supplemental Report Language in quantitative terms with qualitative considerations. The Coordination Site has collaborated with the California Community Colleges in a formal collection and review of current, official articulation not included in the ASSIST Web site; the results of this investigation and an evaluation of what they represent are presented here.

METHODS

Collection

The Coordination Site sent to each Community College ASSIST manager a list of all of its most recent major preparation articulation in ASSIST for each university by major title, along with a summary report counting all of the articulation agreements in ASSIST for the most recent year as of September 2001. The summary counted as an agreement all of the articulation in ASSIST for a pair of institutions for a given year.

Each Community College ASSIST Manager was asked to compare the summary and list of current articulation in ASSIST with all the existing articulation each Community College knew of, whether or not in ASSIST. They were asked to submit to the Coordination Site copies of any official articulation which they found not to be in ASSIST.

Although the California State University (CSU) also maintains articulation agreements in ASSIST for CSU-to-CSU campuses, ASSIST did not solicit articulation not in ASSIST from the CSU campuses.

Review

The Coordination Site reviewed all copies of the articulation submitted by the colleges to ensure that the articulation was indeed missing from the ASSIST Web site.

As the first comprehensive investigation of articulation not in ASSIST, guidelines were developed to weed out reports of articulation possibly in default but no longer relevant to the transfer process. Articulation submitted was reviewed for officiality, currency, and relevancy to the transfer process before adding it to the results matrix.

Official Articulation

The results matrix includes only official articulation, that is, articulation generated by the universities. Advising sheets generated by the colleges (even if existing official articulation was used as a source) are not considered official articulation and are being reviewed separately for content and overlap with articulation in ASSIST. Conversely, some of the universities have drawn up grids of course-to-course articulation extracted from major preparation agreements. Course-to-course articulation from university generated grids is included in the results matrix if it represents current data and is not in ASSIST.

Note: Some universities count courses reviewed but not approved as articulation; the results matrix includes only positive articulation submitted.

Currency

Historical articulation agreements in ASSIST were not reviewed for completeness and accuracy. Indeed, it is at the discretion of the receiving institutions whether or not to maintain historical articulation agreements. This report concerns itself with the completeness and accuracy of the most current articulation agreements in ASSIST.

Official articulation submitted was also reviewed for currency. Course-to-course articulation submitted predating the most current articulation in ASSIST was excluded from the results matrix. The Coordination Site has only limited visibility into the articulation approval process between sending and receiving institutions and was hesitant to make assumptions of university non-compliance when the submitted articulation predates the most recent year. (Articulation not carried forward into the current year could have been omitted with valid reason.) The Coordination Site did, however, include predated major preparation agreements in the results matrix if the entire major was omitted. Sign-off dates or other dates on the paperwork submitted by colleges were used to determine the academic year of the agreements, which were reviewed for currency against the academic year of the most current articulation in ASSIST. Undated articulation was considered to be part of the current academic year. Though this method allows for exclusion of possibly legitimate reports of current course-to-course articulation or error corrections which were not carried forward into current agreements in ASSIST, non-compliance in these cases may not be verified without confirmation from university articulation officers.

RESULTS

Matrix of Articulation Not in ASSIST

The results of the investigation are presented as a matrix of official articulation not in ASSIST (See Appendix). All of the results in the matrix were verified by the Coordination Site for omission, officiality, currency, and relevancy as described above. Pairs of institutions are ordered by college. The actual articulation is listed by university course prefix and number for course-to-course articulation or by major name for major preparation articulation. The date of articulation (using sign-off or other listed dates) and the academic year it falls into are listed, along with the academic year of the most current articulation to be found in ASSIST (if any).

Discussion of Results

Prior to this investigation the Coordination Site was unable to quantify the proportion of all existing articulation that is in ASSIST in response to the Supplementary Report Language as it did not previously know the extent of articulation outside of ASSIST. The ASSIST Board preliminarily responded to the Joint Legislative Committee with the proportion of articulation agreements in ASSIST which were not current based on anecdotal reports received: only 2 of the more than 3,100 current articulation agreements in ASSIST were incomplete in that they were missing official articulation. More precisely, in September 2001 there were 2,842 articulation agreements in ASSIST (not including those of UC San Francisco and UCD School of Veterinary Medicine), with an agreement defined as all articulation for a pair of institutions for a given academic year.

A number of additional incomplete current agreements in ASSIST were uncovered in this investigation. To compare with our original proportion, the numerator increased from the preliminary report from 2 to 52. The proportions are compared below:

In addition to incomplete agreements already in ASSIST, the investigation revealed articulation which comprised 24 new agreements, that is, articulation for new pairs of institutions not yet in ASSIST. From this information, it can now be stated that based on this more comprehensive investigation involving the Community Colleges, the Coordination Site counts the number of all existing articulation agreements as of September 2001 to be 2,866 and can now respond directly to the SLR question. The proportion of all existing articulation that is in ASSIST, counted as annualized agreements and based on the methods in this investigation, is 2842/2866, or 99.16%.

It should be noted that the proportion of articulation not in ASSIST, broadly calculated in terms of annualized agreements, does not respond qualitatively to the kind or value of the articulation not in ASSIST. Though the proportion gives a measure of compliance, the impact of articulation missing from ASSIST on transferring or stimulating transfer is not collapsible into a single proportion or number. By defining a current articulation agreement as all of the most recent articulation in ASSIST for a given pair of institutions, the proportion de-emphasizes the expressed preference by students for major preparation over course-to-course articulation¹. The matrix is included to counterbalance the perspective with specific instances and majors listed for pairs of institutions. Of the 76 incomplete or missing agreements, 37 contained missing course-to-course articulation, and 37 contained missing major preparation articulation (8 contained both kinds). Also important may be the revelation of new pairs of institutions. The segmental offices will likely consider the kind and value of articulation missing as well as the amount of articulation missing when following up with campuses.

Since the responsibility of entering the articulation into ASSIST rests with the receiving institutions, it may be helpful to characterize the articulation by university to highlight certain trends or the extent of problems. The chart on the following page summarizes and characterizes the missing articulation by receiving institution:

CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The results of this investigation have revealed only a slightly greater proportion of articulation missing from ASSIST than estimated on the prior anecdotal evidence. However, since the goal of the complete data policies is to reduce the proportion to 0, a focus on what comprises the numerator, or missing articulation, is important. The Coordination Site therefore suggests that the segments use the results of this investigation as insight to address or understand problems. It can be reported that at least one university with articulation missing from ASSIST is already correcting the problem which resulted from a misunderstanding of the compliance policies. The summary of missing articulation by university shows that for some universities, non-compliance is confined to routinely published articulation from one or two schools within the university without university articulation officer approval. Some universities have in the meantime added articulation since the lengthy verification process in this investigation; in these cases compliance hovers over the 30-day deadline for entering articulation into ASSIST. Using the trends identified or apparent in this report should accelerate progress in attaining 100% compliance.

Finally, the Coordination Site suggests annual monitoring of compliance of the Complete Data Policies through an annual collection and review process similar to this investigation. The annual outcome of this process would be more fruitful and accurate, however, if university articulation officers are involved. Through a broad collaboration of the Coordination Site, the Community College articulation officers, the university articulation officers, and segmental offices, compliance with the Complete Data Policies can be monitored and effectively addressed to help achieve full compliance with the ASSIST Complete Data Policies.
