

**Project ASSIST Campus Advisory Committee
Structure and Charge
November 6, 1995**

The ASSIST Board of Directors has established the ASSIST Campus Advisory Committee as a standing committee to discuss issues and make recommendations to the Board regarding end user issues at participating colleges and universities. This committee will meet at least twice annually to discuss issues regarding implementation, utilization, and database maintenance of Project ASSIST.

Membership:

The membership of the ASSIST Campus Advisory Committee includes representatives from the following agencies in addition to representatives from the ACS:

California Community Colleges

- 2 Student services representatives from different participating colleges, preferably managers of counseling;
- 2 Technical representatives from different participating colleges, preferably MIS Directors;
- 2 ASSIST Project Managers from different participating colleges, preferably with articulation experience;
- 1 Student representative, preferably from an existing community college student advocacy organization;

California State University

- 1 ASSIST Manager from a participating CSU campus, preferably with articulation experience;
- 1 Technical representative from a participating CSU campus;

University of California

- 1 ASSIST Manager from a participating UC campus, preferably with articulation experience; and
- 1 Technical representative from a participating UC campus.
