

ASSIST Data Maintenance Hardware and Software Requirements

This document describes the minimum hardware and software needed to maintain data in ASSIST.

Course List Maintenance:

- Hardware: A computer (PC or Macintosh) providing a graphical user interface.
- A monitor set to a screen resolution of 800x600 or better.
- A direct Internet connection (T1 or faster).
- Software: Netscape Navigator version 3.0 or newer, or Microsoft Internet Explorer version 3.0 or newer.

Articulation Maintenance:

- Hardware: A computer running Microsoft Windows 95 or NT. Microsoft Windows 98 will be supported when it is released. Macintosh, OS/2, MS-DOS and other platforms are not supported.
- A monitor set to a screen resolution of 800x600 or better.
- A direct Internet connection (T1 or faster).
- Software: ASSIST Articulation Maintenance client software (provided by the ACS).
- Sybase Open Client (provided by the ACS).
- Netscape Navigator version 3.0 or newer, or Microsoft Internet Explorer version 3.0 or newer.
